## **VOTERS' MEETING**

The Voters' Meeting will follow the covered dish meal and a special slide presentation of the history of our congregation.

Two items will require action:

1. The Nation Memorial for the Parking Lot is \$1,150. We also have about \$1,500 in the Property Improvement Fund. The recommendation is to use this money to pave the handicap area of the parking lot (62' x 25'). The estimated cost is \$3,000.

2. We had a failure of the drain field for the teacherage septic system. This was due in part to the infiltrator design and to the fact that the system was compromised by broken irrigation pipes. We were forced to replace the drain field and the grinder pump at a cost of \$4,000. The recommendation is that it be financed by an internal loan. This internal loan will be repaid through the "Building Fund."
